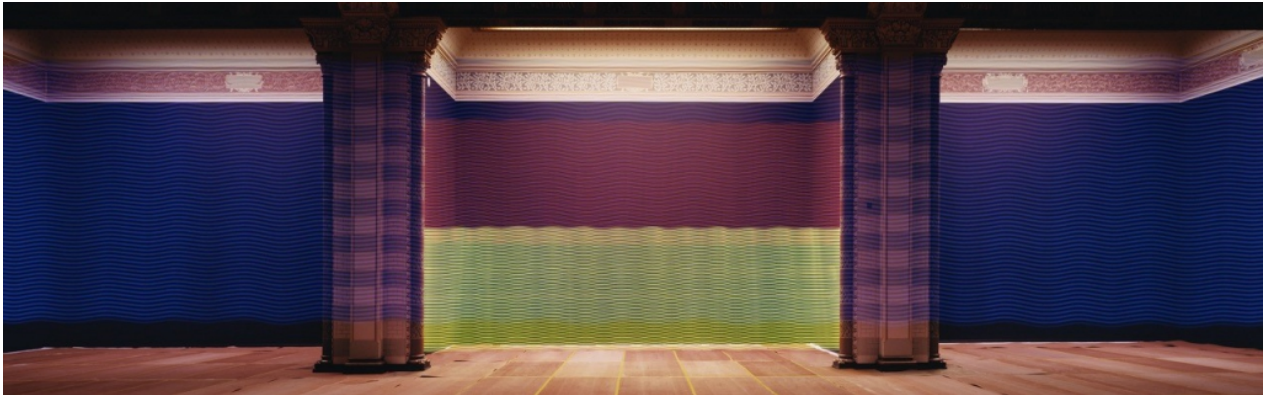

The artworks of **Jean-Marc Spaans** (1967) are photographs of light. He captures the trace of moving light by photography without showing its source. His work has been described as painting with light and could be seen as a visualization of light's energy. Since Spaans himself is the actor that moves the light, his art can also be viewed as works of innovative co-performance between human energy and the energy of light. Mostly hidden from view by the light, Spaans creates the illusion that his light-traces are part of architecture or objects actually constructed or installed in space.

Rijksmuseum Serie, Special Edition. For the Cityscapes Patron's Selection, Spaans made a special edition from his recent Museum series (2015) in which the Rijksmuseum Amsterdam figures as canvas for his 'painting with light'. Illustrative for the layering in Spaans work is the (empty) spot he selected for his depiction of the Rijksmuseum: The Gallery where Rembrandt, our famous 'master of light', resides.
